



Relay Judging Platform Strap Adjustment Instructions

Thank you for purchasing a relay judging platform (RJP or RJPL) from Colorado Time Systems. This instruction sheet will help you understand how the straps are assembled.




Figure 1 - Assembled Relay Judging Platform with mounting strap

Parts: You should have received all the parts shown in Figure 1. The RJP is shipped with the straps fully assembled, but the straps may come apart during shipping. Use this diagram to feed the straps through the proper metal fasteners. Strap Adjustment Instructions

When you receive a new RJP, you must adjust the straps to fit your starting platform.

1. Detach the hook from the buckle.
2. Place the RJP on the starting platform with the front of the RJP (the part with the bend) hanging over the front end of the block.
3. Adjust the fasteners at the positions marked "A" in the above drawing to allow the hook to reattach to the buckle.
4. Attach the hook to the buckle.
5. Pull on the strap at the position marked "B," to tighten the strap assembly.
6. Apply tension until the straps are tight. Then flip the buckle to secure the RJP in place.

Note: After the initial setup to fit the RJP to your starting platform, you should not need to re-adjust the fasteners at the point marked "A." You will only need to tighten the strap by pulling on the position marked "B," then secure the buckle in place.

To lengthen the life of your RJP and straps, do not leave the RJP strapped to your starting platform while not in use.
