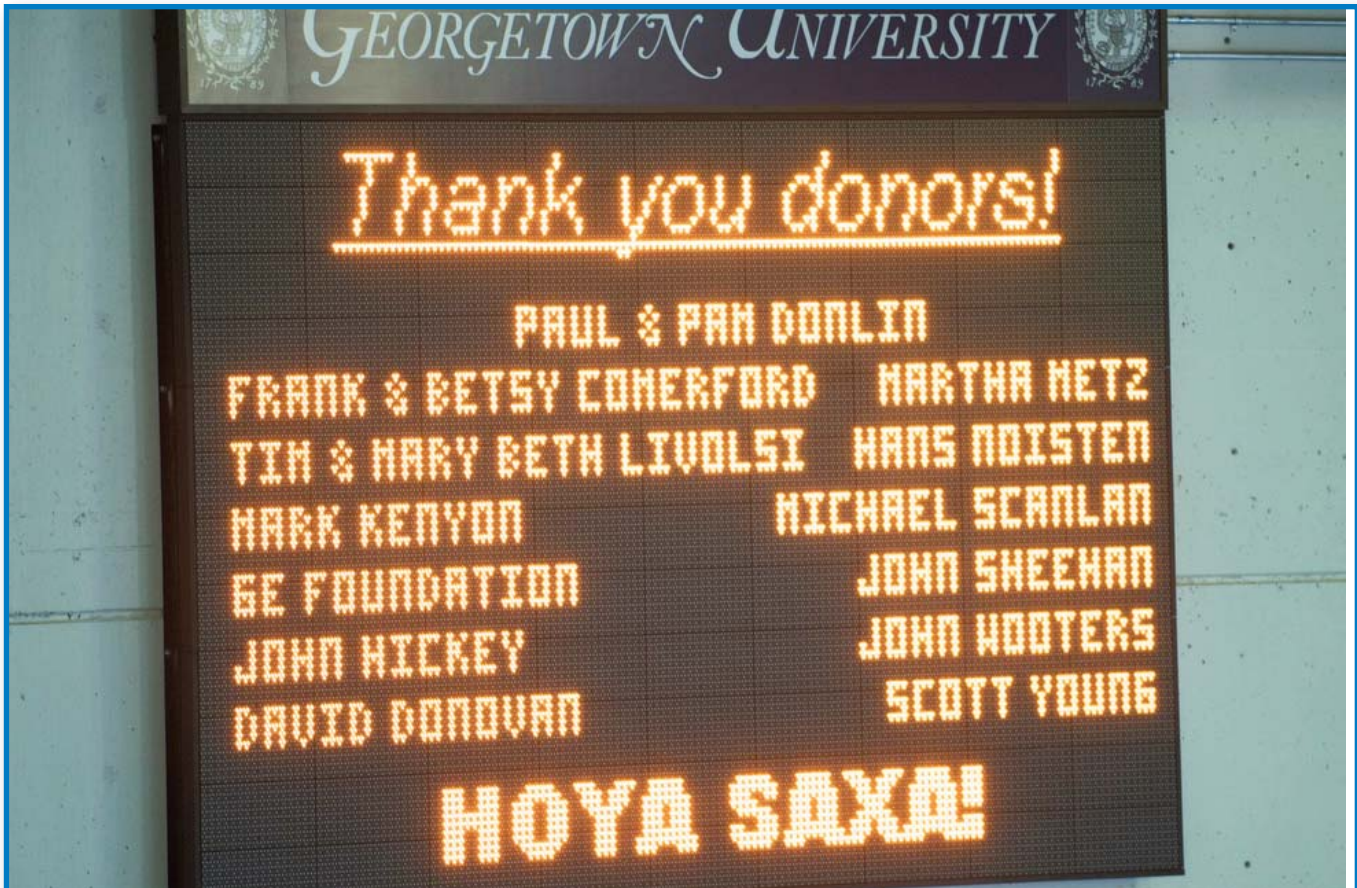


Project Summary

Georgetown University installed a 23mm Amber LED Matrix Display at the Albert G. McCarthy, Jr. Swimming Pool in October 2009. The display measures approximately 7 ft x 11 ft (2.2m x 3.3m) and is capable of displaying animations, logos, and competitor names along with their times.
